

# Knock, Knock, Who is it?

## Game Play Instructions:

### How to play

For two Players

1. Print the blue and red game card sheets.
2. Print and cut out the game cards and game card covers.
3. Each player has a different colored game card sheet.
4. Place all the game cards in a stack face down.
5. Each player takes a turn by choosing a card from the stack. Do not let the other player see the card.
6. The object of the game is to figure out who is knocking at the door (players character card). Is it officer Oliver or Professor Paul? Players take turns asking each other questions about their character in the form of "Knock, Knock, Who Is It?".

Example:

Player 1: "Knock, Knock, Who Is It?"

Player 2: "Does your character wear glasses?"

Player 1: "Yes" if correct "No" if incorrect.

Player 2: "Knock, Knock, Who Is It?"

Player 1: "Does your character have red hair?"

7. Use the game card covers to place on all the characters that do not fit the description. These are the characters that you are eliminating from the game.
8. If the player calls out the name of the character, and it is not the correct one, they lose the game. If it is correct, they win the game.

Optional game play rules:

Each player tries to guess the characters profession by asking questions about the type of job they would do and what would they need to do their job, for example: "Do they work with children?", "Do they use tools?", "Do they help others?", ect.
