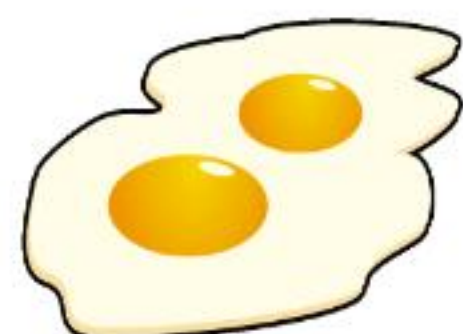

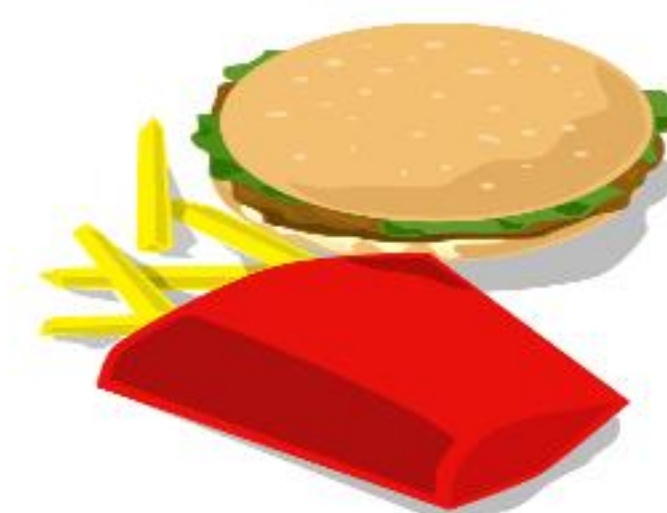

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## Instructions:

1. Print out the Restaurant Menu on heavy paper or card stock. You may need 2-5 menus depending on the amount of guests.
2. Staple or tape pages together like a book.
3. Have the child write on the front cover the name of their restaurant.
4. Print out the Restaurant Place Mat, Paper Plate and the Food Cutouts from [www.kidscanhavefun.com/girls-stuff.htm](http://www.kidscanhavefun.com/girls-stuff.htm)
5. Place small tables around in the house with table cloths (you can use towels or any type of material used for sewing). You can place tables outside for a patio.
6. Place the Restaurant Place Mats on the tables.
6. Have the guests line up at the door and wait to be seated.
7. Place them at a table and hand them a menu.
8. Use the food cutouts to serve them.

## Tips:

Ask what they would like to drink first.

Take their food choices.

Ask them if their food is okay.

Ask them if they would like a hot drink (coffee, tea, hot chocolate) and/or dessert.

Give them the bill.

And don't forget to tip the waitress/waiter.
