

July 4th Pinwheel

1. Print project on both sides of a single sheet of paper.
2. Cut around edges.
3. Using a crafting knife, cut through the lines on the front center of the image, making an "X".
4. Cut along the solid diagonal lines at each of the corners.
5. With the pinwheel face down fold the upper right corner back into the center and tuck into the slit.
6. Fasten with glue or tape. Repeat with each additional corner.
7. Add stickers or draw pictures.
8. Attach the back center of the pinwheel to a stick or dowel. Or use any other item, just make sure it is free to spin.

Option: Instead of tape or glue, fasten the folded corners with a brass fastener.
